



ARRT Personal Data Privacy Statement General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR)

In May 2018 new regulations, the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), comes into force concerning how personal data is handled and how consent is given. These regulations do not change how the Arun & Rother Rivers Trust (ARRT) currently stores, handles or uses your data. This page summarises the ARRT policy regarding the GDPR. The information below states how your data is used and how long it will be retained;

- ARRT will record the personal information contained in your supporter application on computer and use it to administer your application.
- ARRT does not sell or pass on your details to third parties.
- The Trust has and will only collect data from adults and it has not knowingly collected data from children. Should the Trust plan to collect personal data from children it will review its procedures and build in suitable protection as required. Persons under 16 years are defined as children.
- Name, address records will only be used to contact you and mail our newsletter or publications to you.
- Your telephone number will only be used to contact you.
- Your email address will only be used to contact you and to distribute electronic versions of our newsletter.
- Your bank details will only be used to send your standing order agreement to your bank (supporters).
- ARRT does not hold any credit/debit card details.
- If your ARRT support ceases for any reason (including a request to withdraw your support, death or failure to pay your annual supporter fee), your records are retained for a period of 7 years for accounting purposes but will not be used to contact you or your representative.
- The information may be used for fraud prevention or money laundering prevention.
- By applying and/or continuing your support of ARRT you consent to our processing your personal data for the above purposes.

All supporters or contacts have a right to ask for a copy of their information and to correct any inaccuracies. When you give us personal information about another person we will assume that they have appointed you to act for them and have consented to the processing of their personal data, including sensitive personal data. We may contact you by mail or email to let you know about events which may be of interest to you. If you do not wish to receive such information you can inform us at any time in writing, by email or by phone.
