

Upper Arun River Revival



Starting in 2019, this three year project led by the Arun & Rother Rivers Trust, focused on the upper portion of the River Arun, aimed at identifying ways to improve the Water Framework Directive status of the river, and develop strategies for the future.

This project delivered a range of work including:

- 35 km of river walkover surveys
- Bank erosion protection
- Tree planting for river shade
- Invasive Non-Native Species mapping, education and eradication
- Work with landowners covering more than 3000 ha of land, providing information and guidance
- Developed plans to improve fish passage and habitats
- Produced farm plans for enhancements for river, floodplain and wildlife
- A suite of legacy projects for future development
